I apologize in advance. I am very sorry. I do realize the seriousness of the conversation...BUT when I see this post it makes me want to say:

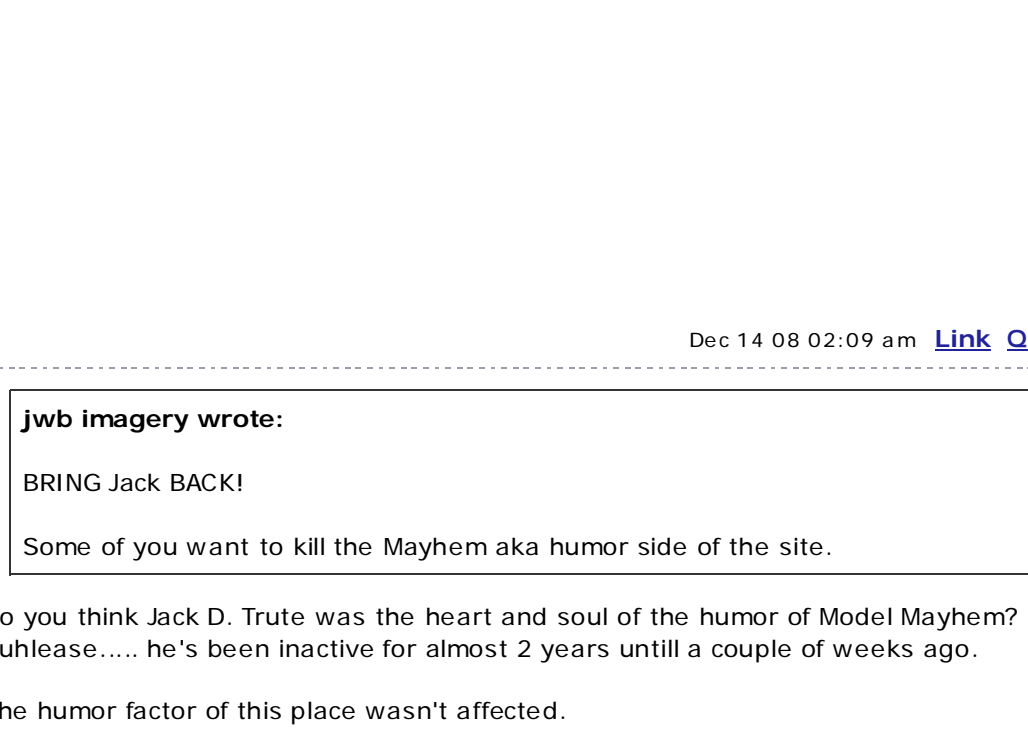
